Total commitment is required from parents and children. There is no point in having your child Baptised if you do not fully commit to Sacramental preparation and a lifelong practise of the faith. If you wish to have your child Baptised, please speak to Fr Kevin after Mass and fill out the required form.

Baptismal courses will take place on the last Monday of each month.
